Inactivated 15 March 1956 in Korea

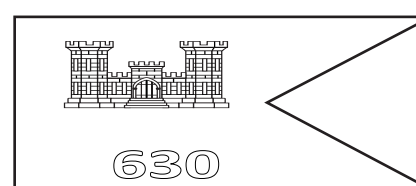
Activated 21 June 1963 at Fort Chaffee, Arkansas

Inactivated 28 August 1971 in Vietnam

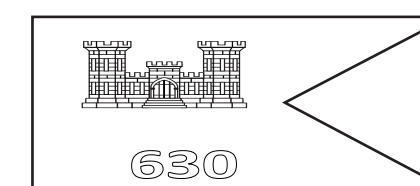
Activated 16 September 1980 in Germany
